The following support will be provided by this Cell:

- a. Help Temporary and Probationary Lecturers explore and identify suitable postgraduate programs within and outside Sri Lanka for their postgraduate studies
- b. Help Temporary and Probationary Lecturers explore and identify scholarships, assistantships and funding institutions that can support their postgraduate studies.
- c. Help Temporary and Probationary Lecturers with writing and revising their statement of purpose, research proposal, writing sample and other components of their application
- d. Help Temporary and Probationary Lecturers identify potential academics who can assist them with their applications or offer them specialist guidance in developing their research proposal
- e. Organize seminars and discussions on contemporary theories and issues relevant for framing the research interests of Temporary and Probationary Lecturers
- f. Organize workshops and sessions on writing the statement of purpose and research proposal for postgraduate studies
- g. Facilitate meetings between potential applicants and academics who visit Jaffna from other parts of Sri Lanka and abroad
