658 Graduates Awarded Degrees in Faculty of Arts in Academic year 2020

The Faculty of Arts of the University of Jaffna is one of the largest faculties in the Sri Lankan Universities comprising 17 departments with 27 study disciplines. Currently, the Faculty of Arts is one of the major stakeholders of the University of Jaffna with the highest student population and academic disciplines.


The Faculty of Arts is unique in its traditional and cultural background. It has adopted dynamic policies for quality in education and focuses on contemporary approaches towards teaching, learning and research activities.

A total number of 658 graduates have completed their degree programmes in the Faculty of Arts, University of Jaffna during the academic year 2020. The conferment of their degrees took place at the 35th General Convocation – 2021 held on the 24th and 25th of February 2021 at the Indoor Stadium of the University.

Nearly 79% of these graduates were females. These graduates hope to enter the world of work with motivation and enthusiasm to bring about transformation at various levels.

The Bachelor of Arts degree was conferred upon 460 graduates. Of these graduates, 333 received Honours degrees and 127 General Degrees.

The Bachelor of Laws degree was conferred upon 49 graduates and the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree was conferred upon 149 graduates.

Unceasing Teaching-Learning Activities during Pandemic

The outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic has caused unprecedented disruption in almost all spheres of life. Education is among the areas that have been hit hard by the arrival of this virus. Due to social-distancing policies adopted by governments all over the world, many universities and educational institutions have ceased teaching in the traditional classroom setting for at least three months.

Academic activities in the Faculty of Arts of the University of Jaffna came to a halt in mid-March 2020 with the announcement made by the University Grants Commission to shut down all public universities in the country until further notice.

However, the Faculty of Arts explored all possible alternative avenues of teaching and learning for this period and enhanced its online teaching and learning facilities to help the students and teachers to engage in academic activities from the safety of their homes. The Faculty has taken a number of appropriate measures to ensure that students from marginalized socio-economic backgrounds are not excluded from the ongoing online academic activities.

The reason for adopting a virtual classroom and multimodal online teaching delivery patterns in the Faculty of Arts was to keep the staff and students of the Faculty academically engaged during these challenging times.



European Union Delegation's Visit to the Department of Media Studies






Media Studies Students participate in the Discussion on 'What Makes Women Set Backed?'


R Media Studies Assist the Telecasting and ♡ Documenting of the University Convocation – 2021

Faulty of Arts Wins the Competitive Grant of 100 Million under AHEAD



The Faulty of Arts, University of Jaffna won the competitive grant of 100 million Sri Lankan Rupees for the execution period of three years under the AHEAD project that has been supported by the World Bank Group in 2019. Proudly, this is the first development grant awarded to the Faculty of Arts based on the completive evaluation of the proposals submitted by different faculties in the state Universities of Sri Lanka.

The project aims to support the Faculty of Arts, University of Jaffna to produce Arts students who are 'well-qualified academically' and 'trained professionally for the world of work' and 'mobilized for wider civic and social life'.

The activities are designed holistically to achieve this aim. In last two years of the execution of this project, 68 % of the outcomes were achieved. The remaining outcome will be achieved before end of May 2022.

Progress of the Project

- Academic staff were trained in OBE and LCT based curriculum development. The Curriculum of 25 Disciplines were revised and implemented from the academic year of 2018/2019. 370 students were trained to enhance their soft skills.
- Academic, administrative & academic supporting staff were trained in handling virtual platforms. The establishment work of 15 SMART class rooms were partially completed. The establishment work of a Research Lab and students' study areas are ongoing.
- Visually challenged students underwent special training. A support center for persons with disability has been fully furnished with special equipment and is ready to function. The course syllabus for second and modern languages are placed to the Faculty Board for approval.
- A Research HUB has organized 10 seminars for Level 04 students with stakeholder representatives to identify the research gaps at local and regional levels. Five meetings were conducted with the above-mentioned stakeholders to create collaboration.
- The revised English course curricula were implemented from the academic year 2018/2019. The establishment work of an English Lab is going on. A process to purchase specific software platforms to cater to the teaching and learning activities is underway.






Higher Studies

A Comparative Study of Two Megalithic Cultural Centers in Northern Sri Lanka (Iranaimadu and Nakapaduvan)

Mrs.Thulasika Dineshan, Lecturer(Prob.), Department of History published a book with the title of 'வட இலங்கையில் பெருங்கற்காலப் பண்பாட்டு மையங்களின் ஒப்பீட்டு ஆய்வு - இரணைமடு, நாகபடுவான்' (Comparative Research on the Sites of Norther Sri Lanka's Megalithic Culture (Iranaimadu & Nakabaduvan) in January 2021.

The spread of Megalithic culture marks the beginning of a new phase in Sri Lanka's cultural history. This book demonstrates with evidence that Iranaimadu and Nakapaduvan, two centers associated with Megalithic culture, were inhabited by people from the pre-historical period to the historical period. It also offers detailed analyses of the social, political, economic, technological, religious and artistic aspects of the lives of the people who lived in these two centers and the ways in which they were similar and different from one another, while bringing out the ties that existed between them.

Tagore's Jaffna Visit: Art, Identity, Discourse

Dr. T. Sanathanan, Senior Lecturer, Department of Fine Arts published a book with the title of 'தாகூரின் யாழ்ப்பாண வருகை: கலை, அடையாளம், கருத்தாடல்' (Tagore's Jaffna Visit: Art, Identity, Discourse) by the Kumaran Book House, Colombo in 2021.

This book, while recording Rabindranath Tagore's Sri Lankan and Jaffna visits through Newspaper reports, tries to reveal the cultural politics of his visit.
