Assignment – Field engagement to facilitate constitutional literacy, participatory democracy, and civic engagement activities

Duration: December 2025 – May 2026 (6 months)

- Ability to work with children and community groups in a participatory and inclusive manner.
- Self-motivated and able to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Public speaking and facilitation skills
